We were so grateful for all you prayers over the last month. As most of you know, Cindy had surgery for breast cancer on August 15th, had a bad reaction to meds and had the same surgery re-opened on August 16th and after some other complications finally came home on August 20th cancer free. We were so excited and I know she just expected to be on the mend shortly. On Sept 20th her doctor said she could ride her bicycle again. So Cindy headed out on her regular routes and last Saturday decided to branch out a little. It was too soon and she fell on the newer route. Besides the road rash and bruises, she completely tore the right side of her mastectomy wound open. She was back in the hospital for a few days to clean it out and sew it up again and came home. Today, she's back in the hospital with a bad wound infected. She'll be there several days while they try to save the wound with antibiotics. So, sigh, that's a lot of our life right now and she appreciates

your prayers and, most of you know, her privacy as much as is possible.

Other than that, Mrs Lincoln, the play has been great. I have such wonderful local churches which have included us in ministry this last month. You can see the pictures of us ministering at Church of the Trinity in Sarasota where I sang with the delightful Ollie Dill and Cindy played for me to sing with Vanessa – a wonderful new singer at our church. I love the little concerts we do there. They introduce new singers in a cozy situation, give us chances to share our stories in more depth and keep the use of church resources at a minimum (no big sound systems to be set up, no sanctuary to cool down, etc).

Suncoast MCC in Venice did the same thing. When I get to sing with Nancy Wilson, I can dig up some songs that I'm no longer able to sing in those lovely original keys – Nancy is like love (that covers a multitude of sins \bigcirc I Peter 4:8). And finally in September, the Florida Network of Metropolitan Community Churches had a gathering at MCC Tampa. I got to reconnect with the fabulous Orgena Rose and got to hear her sing a bit. Then on the final morning, I was able to share the song "Stand Closer". Jesus, speaking to the Pharisees in Luke, said that it was great that they were so careful about keeping the law, but that they completely forgot to share the love of God. "This you ought to have done and not left the other undone." That's how I felt about the murder of George Floyd when I wrote those lyrics: great that I've worked so hard for justice for the LGBTQIA community. Sad that I didn't work harder for other communities. Stand closer.
